For most products sold in the EU, the use of CE Marking and a Declaration of Conformity are mandatory. The CE mark certifies that a product has met EU consumer safety, health or environmental requirements as outlined in the European Directive. In all, there are about 25 directives that require CE Marking ranging from toy safety, machinery, and low-voltage equipment to terminal equipment and electromagnetic compatibility.

Manufacturers are responsible for ensuring that the products they place in the European market meet all relevant regulations. This seminar will explore the requirements and process of obtaining a CE mark.
