WHY GLOBAL PETROLEUM SHOW?

Demand for Alberta's bitumen continues to expand significantly. Alberta's oil and gas extraction producers are in the midst of a \$24.2 billion spending binge this year, boosting their outlays by nearly 18% relative to 2010, according to intentions expressed in *Statistics Canada's Private and Public Investment* survey released in February. There has been an almost 50% increase in the capital budgets of companies developing oil sands projects, running on average \$19 billion range.

GPS continues to expand in size, covering over 600,000 net square feet in exhibit space. It is said to be one of the largest energy events bringing together global producers, EPC's, service companies and suppliers. GPS offers the chance to source new products, find new business partners, and network with international and domestic professionals.
